Each banknote, which, on examination of various security features / parameters, is determined as a counterfeit one, shall be branded with a stamp "COUNTERFEIT BANKNOTE". For this purpose, a stamp with a uniform size of $\mathbf{5}$ cm \mathbf{x} $\mathbf{5}$ cm with the following inscription may be used.
